- The board of education is ignoring decades of the will of Cabell County's voters, who have consistently and overwhelmingly approved school excess levy funds to support our parks and libraries.
- The current levy lasts until mid-2025. No teacher benefits or programs will lose funding if the proposed school excess levy is voted down in May.
- A NO vote in May gives the board of education a chance to submit a revised levy for the November election. It is a reset, not a final decision.
- The board of education's proposed 2024 school excess levy will cost the county's libraries at least \$750,000 per year in funding over four years, compared to what they would have received under the current, taxpayerapproved excess levy.
- Library services will have to be reduced. Some branch libraries may close.
